Atlanta Sustainable Building Ordinance Up For a Vote



The Atlanta Sustainable Building Ordinance (ASBO) will go before the Atlanta City Council's Community Development/Human Resources Committee (CD/HR) on December 1 for a decisive vote after months of negotiations, consensus building and multiple drafts. The ordinance is being proposed by Sustainable Atlanta, a non-profit organization whose primary function is to bring together leaders from business, civic and governmental sectors to create sustainable policy and programs in Atlanta.
